Roisin (Rosh) is a Cornish-Irish director, writer, facilitator and educator specialising in new writing, adaptations and socially engaged work. She studied English Literature and Drama at the University of Exeter before training as a director at Bristol Old Vic Theatre School. She is interested in work that connects and creates a shared sense of humanity, be that addressing social and political topics, or finding a joyful and effervescent escape from them. She is especially keen to engage regional artists and audiences through her work.

In addition to her directing, Roisin has been commissioned to write a number of pieces for O-Region, Taunton Brewhouse and Kneehigh and is currently developing new works with support from Hall for Cornwall, Michael Grandage Company and Exeter Northcott Theatre. She has also held positions in artist development, education and outreach at the Royal Shakespeare Company, Bristol Old Vic Theatre School, Salisbury Playhouse/Arts Centre/International Arts Festival and guest lectures at a range of universities and colleges. She is currently a trustee for Wiltshire Creative.

Roisin is a recipient of the prestigious Michael Grandage Company's Futures Award.
